Dear Anna,


Please find enclosed a group application for coastal permits to replace those due to expire for 128 of the moorings in Waikawa Bay.


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## 1 Executive Summary

This application is submitted by the Marlborough Berth & Mooring Association (MBMA) on behalf of a number of its members who own swing moorings in Waikawa Bay, Marlborough Sounds.

A Mooring Management Bylaw 2011 (the Bylaw) was approved (in terms of the Local Government Act 1974) by Council in May 2011. The Bylaw is an alternative form for regulatory management of moorings in the Bay to the current coastal permits (under the Resource Management Act 1991). The Bylaw will allow for a simple licensing system for moorings rather than requiring individual resource consents. New Mooring Management Areas (MMA's) were also approved in which all existing moorings are to be located. These MMA's are shown in maps in the Marlborough Sounds Resource Management Plan.

Short term coastal permits for the existing moorings in their current locations were granted in 2011 to allow time for formal ratification of the Bylaw and resolving of the practicalities of establishing existing moorings within the approved MMA's.

The above matters were part of Plan Change 21 (PC21) which included a proposed new Marina Zone promoted by Port Marlborough New Zealand Ltd (PMNZ). The MMA's and Bylaw were approved, but the extension to the Marina Zone was not granted. PMNZ however appealed the whole of the decision on PC21. The appeal was finally resolved by means of a Consent Order issued by the Environment Court on 20 August 2015.

Since granting of the Consent Order, Council has been working on preparing the Bylaw for ratification by the full Council and also has been assessing the administration and practical considerations of establishing existing moorings within the approved MMA's.

In the meantime, the short term Coastal Permits for most of the moorings in the Bay are due to expire on 4 May 2016.

This is a group application for short term coastal permits for moorings which are due to expire. Note that some mooring owners have made their own applications.

It is very important to understand at the outset that no new moorings are being proposed nor are any changes to existing moorings proposed. This application is only for short term coastal permits until such time as the existing moorings can be legally managed under the Bylaw and also be contained within the MMA's that are already defined in the Marlborough Sounds Resource Management Plan.

There are no new matters that have arisen since granting of the existing consents which may give rise to new adverse effects that were not previously assessed in the course of processing PC 21.

The proposal is in accord with the New Zealand Coastal Policy Statement to the extent that it provides a holding pattern while the Bylaw becomes operational and the moorings are located within the MMA's.

The same applies as above in regards to the objectives and policies of the Marlborough Sounds Resource Management Plan.

In this context, the proposal meets the purpose of the Resource Management Act as set out in Section 5 - the sustainable management of natural and physical resources.

## 2 Background

Existing moorings in Waikawa Bay were authorised by previous legislation under a Harbour Board Bylaw. After 1991, moorings were required by law to be validated under the Resource Management Act (RMA).

There were a number of options to validate the existing moorings under the RMA. Council decided that individual mooring holders should apply for a coastal permit under the RMA. The individual applications were publicly notified. Port Marlborough New Zealand Ltd (PMNZ) submitted on mooring applications as it wanted to expand its marina facilities in Waikawa Bay.


MBMA was formed around this time to represent the interests of mooring and also marina berth holders in Marlborough. MBMA is an incorporated society with over 300 subscribed members. The objectives of MBMA include the improvement of availability, tenure and charging regimes for berth holders in marinas and the representation of mooring holders.

A single hearing was held for all mooring applications in Waikawa Bay as a group lot in April 2008. The hearing Commissioner identified fundamental legal flaws in being able to approve all of the existing moorings. This was mainly due to the fact that many moorings had been established in an ad hoc fashion and had significantly overlapping swing circles.

The hearing was adjourned to enable the parties to discuss alternative methods to deal with the issues. MBMA was convinced that if it tried to pursue the route of individual resource consents for each mooring, it could have only resulted in a large number of mooring applications being declined.

It was therefore in both MBMA's and PMNZ's interests to look for a 'bay wide' comprehensive solution to the issue of accommodation of boats in Waikawa Bay that would best suit the interests of both parties and also the wider community.

The agreed solution was for a Plan Change application (PC21) that would include new Mooring Management Areas (MMA's) to accommodate existing moorings and also to provide for a new Marina Zone on the north-west side of the Bay. A bylaw to manage the moorings within the MMA's was also proposed. This bylaw will



allow for a simple licensing system for moorings rather than requiring individual resource consents on a continuing basis.

The Bylaw, MMA's and short term coastal permits for existing moorings in Waikawa Bay were approved in May 2011. Short term coastal permits for the moorings were issued to allow time for formal ratification of the Bylaw and for resolving the practicalities of establishing existing moorings within the approved MMA's. The part of PC21 for extension to the existing marina zone was declined by Council. PMNZ appealed the decision not to grant the marina zone extension and also appealed the part of the decision to grant the coastal permits for the moorings.

The appeal in regards to the granting of the temporary coastal permits for the moorings was ultimately withdrawn. Plan Change 21 was approved by Consent Order issued by the Environment Court on 20 August 2015 to the extent that the proposed *Marina Zone* to the northwest of the existing marina was granted but the existing northeast undeveloped marina zone is to revert to *Coastal Marine Zone*.

Unfortunately the appeal process has taken up most of the five year term of the short term coastal permits for the existing moorings and Council is still working on ratifying the Bylaw and implementing the MMA's.

This application is for short term coastal permits for the subject moorings in Waikawa Bay to allow the above matters to be sorted by Council.

### 3 Location


Waikawa Bay is one of a number of bays in Queen Charlotte Sound (Tōtaranui). It is adjacent to the Waikawa settlement some 32km south-west of the northern entrance to the Sound and 12.5km from the head of the Sound at Anakiwa.

The general location of the Bay is shown in the map in Appendix 1.

The moorings that are the subject of this application are located at the head of Waikawa Bay. The aerial photograph in Appendix 2 shows the various features of the Bay including the swing moorings and the Mooring Management Areas.

### 4 Receiving Environment

Waikawa Bay has an area of approximately 240ha with headlands at Karaka Point on the eastern side and The Snout on the western side.



The Waikawa marina lies at the head of the Bay, encompassing approximately 17ha. The marina is operated by PMNZ.

The Waikawa Bay settlement lies at the head and around the perimeters of the Bay with most residential activity on the southern and eastern sides. The western side has sparse residential development and a corresponding higher degree of natural character.

There is a large group of moorings located at the head of the Bay, most of which are the subject of this application. Note that some moorings closer to the marina and on the western side have longer term consent and are therefore not part of this application. Also some mooring owners have lodge individual resource consent applications for their moorings rather than being a part of this application.

The seabed at the location of the swing moorings is comprised of uniform, soft, marine sediments.

#### 4.1 Statutory Acknowledgements

Statutory acknowledgements are set out in the document *Te Tau Ihu – Statutory Acknowledgements 2014* which is an attachment to the Marlborough Sounds Resource Management Plan.

All Te Tau Ihu Iwi have traditional, historical, cultural and spiritual associations with the coast in the top of the South Island.

Te Atiawa exercise kaitiakitanga with the strongest customary authority over Queen Charlotte Sound (Totoranui), the islands within it and its wider environs. Waikawa Bay is rich in history for Te Atiawa. It was a main waka site and was the food cupboard of Te Atiawa. The Bay was extensively fished and actively managed by them. It is historically, culturally and spiritually significant to Te Atiawa.

## 5 Proposal

It is proposed that new coastal permits be issued for the swing moorings identified in the list in Appendix 3.

There is a total of 139 moorings with existing coastal permits which are due to expire on 4 May 2016 and which require a new coastal permit.

There is also another existing mooring (M3191) which has been allocated a place in the MMA's and which a previous coastal permit was applied for, but for which no consent appears to have been granted in 2011.

Of the total of 140 moorings under consideration, this application covers 128 moorings which are listed with all relevant details in Appendix 3. The balance of 12 moorings have been applied for individually by others.

Issuing of new coastal permits will allow time for formal ratification of the Mooring Management Bylaw and the sorting of the practicalities of establishing existing moorings within the approved Mooring Management Areas.

It is proposed that a condition be imposed on any consent that may issue, requiring that the coastal permits expire when both the Bylaw is implemented and the moorings are all positioned within the MMA's.

All of the swing moorings are traditional structures with a concrete block on the seafloor, a length of heavy chain attached to that to provide shock resistance to tidal, wave and wind effects and then a length of rope (warp) attached to a buoy. The rope is attached boats when they are moored.

## 6 Activity Status

### 6.1 Resource Management Act

Section 12 (1) of the Resource Management Act 1991 (the Act) states that (paraphrased): *no person may, unless expressly allowed by a national environmental standard, a rule in a regional coastal plan or a resource consent:*

*(b) erect reconstruct, place, alter, extend, remove or demolish any structure or any part of a structure that is fixed in, on, under or over any foreshore or seabed unless expressly allowed by a rule in a regional coastal plan or by resource consent;*


*(c) disturb any foreshore or seabed in a manner that has or is likely to have an adverse effect on the foreshore or seabed (other than for the purpose of lawfully harvesting any plant or animal);*

The moorings that are the subject of this application are all in place. No new structures are proposed.

The moorings are required to be serviced every two years, necessitating at times the lifting of the mooring blocks for servicing or checking. Minor seabed disturbance occurs when the blocks are lifted or placed back in position.

Section 12 (2)(a) of the Act states that (paraphrased): *no person may, unless expressly allowed by a national environmental standard, a rule in a regional coastal plan or a resource consent: occupy any part of the common marine and coastal area.*

Continued occupation of the coastal marine area is proposed to the extent required for the mooring block and tackle and swing circle of the vessels on the swing mooring structures.



## 6.2 Marlborough Sounds Resource Management Plan

All of the moorings in question are located within *Coastal Marine Zone One* (CMZ1) under the Marlborough Sounds Resource Management Plan (the Plan). Many of the moorings are currently within *Mooring Management Areas* (MMA's) which are indicated on the aerial photograph in Appendix 2 and are also identified in map 61 in the Plan. The exception to this are moorings around the periphery of the MMA's and within areas designated as transit lanes between MMA's.

Rule 35.1.2.13 states:

*Placement, use (including occupation of the coastal marine area) and maintenance of swing moorings within a Mooring Management Area or Waka swing moorings within the Waka Mooring Management Area shall be a permitted activity subject to the following condition: a) A bylaw is in place and a current Mooring Licence under the bylaw provides for the placement and use of the specified swing mooring.*

As the Bylaw is not yet ratified by the full Council the moorings that are within the MMA's are limited discretionary activities in accordance with Rule 35.3.2 of the Plan. Council has limited its discretion to the following matters:

- a) Location within a Mooring Management Area or Waka Mooring Management Area;*
- b) The type and specification of mooring including the swing arc;*
- c) The availability of space within the Mooring Management Area or Waka Mooring Management Area;*
- d) The reservation of space for the relocation of moorings in Appendix J, Schedule 4.1;*
- e) The ability of the activity to comply with permitted activity noise standard, being Rule 35.1.1.4.1. 35.3.2.1.2*


The Rule also states:

*Applications made in accordance with Rule 35.3.2 will be considered without public notification and may be considered without either the service of notice, or without the need to obtain written approval of affected persons in accordance with the Act.*

A total of 59 moorings of this group application have been identified as having either their mooring blocks or swing circles outside the boundaries of the MMA's and are therefore discretionary activities in accordance with Rule 35.4. Those moorings are identified in the list in Appendix 4.

## 7 Assessment

It is very important to understand with this assessment that no new moorings are being proposed, nor are any changes to existing moorings proposed. This application is only for short term coastal permits for the existing moorings until such time as they can be legally managed under the Mooring Management Bylaw 2011 and also are contained within the Mooring Management Areas that are defined in the Plan.



## 7.1 Actual & Potential Effects

### Effects on Neighbourhood, Community

The effects on the neighbourhood and community are the same as they have been for a number of years. The moorings and boats anchored on them have become an accepted part of Waikawa Bay.

When the proposed Bylaw is finally in place and moorings have all been evenly spaced out and relocated to be entirely within the MMA's, there will be a greater buffer between moored boats and adjacent residential and recreational areas. This will improve the amenity of the area.

### Effects on the Locality, Landscape, Visual

Waikawa Bay is not identified in the Plan as having significant or outstanding landscape values. The landscape and visual values of the Bay are heavily modified by the existing residential development, the Waikawa Marina and the associated commercial and industrial development.

Most of the existing moorings have been in place for many years and the mooring floats and boats on them are an accepted part of this modified landscape.

### Effects on Ecosystems

The seabed at the location of the swing moorings is comprised of uniform, soft, marine sediments. It is not mapped in the Plan as having any particular ecological significance.


The chain component of swing moorings causes mechanical disturbance of the seabed when it is dragged across the seabed as a result of moored boats swinging in response to winds and currents. Also there is minor disturbance of the seabed when mooring blocks are re-positioned when the moorings are serviced. This has been occurring for many years.

Given that the swing circles of most moorings overlap with adjacent swing circles, the seabed under the current moorings in the Bay has limited ecological value as a result of the disturbance particularly by the mooring chains over many years.

No changes are proposed in this application that would result in any new areas of seabed disturbance.

This application for coastal permits is to allow time for the MMA/ Bylaw regime to be implemented.

When the moorings are all shifted into the MMA's the area of seabed disturbance will be reduced. In order to accommodate all existing moorings in the MMA's, some will need to be on a bungy cord mooring system as opposed to the traditional chain and warp. This will further reduce seabed disturbance as the bungy cord is suspended off the seabed.



#### **Effects on Aesthetic, Recreational, Scientific, Historical, Spiritual, or Cultural Values**

Te Atiawa exercise kaitiakitanga customary authority over Queen Charlotte Sound (Totoranui), the islands within it and its wider environs. Waikawa Bay is rich in history for Te Atiawa. It was a main waka site and was the food cupboard of Te Atiawa. The Bay was extensively fished and actively managed by them. It is historically, culturally and spiritually significant to them.

In terms of recreation, Waikawa Bay is dominated by its use for mooring, berthing, launching and maintaining boats. The moorings by their nature limit other recreational activity within them.

The beach at Waikawa Bay recreation reserve is a dedicated marine swimming area and defined on its seaward margins by yellow marker floats. Some long distance swimmers also use the wider Bay area but usually avoid the area where boats are moored.

There is a rowing club based at the southern end of the reserve area and the Bay waters are used by rowers for training. These small craft transit relatively easily through the moorings.

There are no new effects on spiritual, cultural or recreational values that will result from this application.

There are no particular aesthetic, scientific or historical values of significance at or near the site.

#### **Effects of Discharge of Contaminants**


The proposal for moorings in itself does not involve any discharge of contaminants to the environment.

#### **Risk Through Natural Hazards, Hazardous Substances, Hazardous Installations**

Moored boats require the application of antifouling paint on their hulls to prevent the build-up of algae, shellfish and other organisms. By nature, antifouling compounds are toxic and usually target the juvenile stages of organisms to inhibit settlement or growth on boat hulls.

Antifouling compounds are released in small quantities into the water column where boats are moored. This issue is more relevant in marinas where boats are moored much more densely than with swing moorings and where there is also limited water flow and exchange.

Antifouling paint technology is improving all the time and considerable effort is being made by manufacturers to minimise effect of the paints beyond the hull of boats that it is applied to.



Amended rules for the use and disposal of antifouling paints came into force in New Zealand on 1 July 2015. The rules result from an extensive reassessment of antifoulants by the country's Environmental Protection Agency. A number of the most toxic compounds have now been banned or are being phased out.

In the context of the approved MMA's and the existence of moorings in this general area for some time, the effects of antifoulants in this environment is within acceptable limits.

### **Safe Navigation**

Users of the Bay have been navigating through and around the existing moorings for some time and have become used to doing so. There are however currently no clearly defined navigational routes through the moorings and in particular to the Waikawa Bay jetty, reserve and launching ramp. Some boats in certain wind conditions lie relatively close together, necessitating other vessels to navigate around them.

The proposed MMA's will considerably improve navigation. Clear fairways will be available between MMA's and around the foreshore when the Bylaw and MMA's are implemented. This will provide for safer transit routes within and around the moorings and between main areas of interest and use in the Bay. It will also provide for better safety for swimmers and those in smaller craft such as kayakers.

Granting of new resource consents for the moorings in their existing locations will allow time for the improved MMA/ Bylaw regime to be implemented.


### **Structural Integrity of Moorings**

All current resource consents for moorings have a condition requiring moorings to be serviced on at least a two yearly basis and for the results of that service to be reported to Council. It is expected that a similar condition will be placed on any consent granted to this application. This will help ensure the safety of the structures, the boats moored to them and also safety of the public who use the Bay.

### **Effects on Associated Land-Based Facilities**

The facilities that service boats on the existing moorings include:

- The Jorgensen boatyard jetty;
- The Waikawa Bay fixed jetty;
- The Waikawa Bay boat launching ramp and floating jetty;
- The Waikawa Bay recreation reserve toilet and shower facilities;



- Car, trailer and dinghy parking in the vicinity of the Waikawa Marina and Waikawa Recreation Reserve;
- Fuel and septic pump out facilities in the Waikawa Marina;
- Boat servicing industries located mainly at the Waikawa Marina.

These facilities have developed to accommodate boating activity centred in the Bay including boats that occupy the moorings.

While improvements could be made to better accommodate boating activity, such as dedicated areas for dinghy storage, granting consent to the existing moorings will not result in any increase in use of those facilities.

## 7.2 New Zealand Coastal Policy Statement

The New Zealand Coastal Policy Statement 2010 (NZCPS) sets out objectives and policies to provide guidance on a national scale on how to achieve the purpose of the Act in respect to the coastal environment. They are principally guidance to regional Councils for their regional coastal plans. The Marlborough Sounds Resource Management Plan mimics most of the NZCPS objectives and policies.

**Policy 6(2)(a)** - *recognise potential contributions to the social, economic and cultural wellbeing of people and communities from use and development of the coastal marine area.*

Comment: The moorings in this area provide for the ability for the owner, their families and friends to access and enjoy the Marlborough Sounds by boat. They provide an alternative to the considerably more expensive berths in the Waikawa Marina and also an alternative to the limitations in size and type of boat that can be trailered and launched at boat ramps. In so doing, the moorings provide for a greater range of boating experience for a wider range of the public.


## 7.3 National Environmental Standards or Regulations

There are no relevant National Environmental Standards or Regulations.

## 7.4 Marlborough Regional Policy Statement

**Policy 7.1.10** - *To enable appropriate type, scale and location of activities by clustering activities with similar effects and ensuring activities reflect the character and facilities available in the communities in which they are located.*

Comment: The application is for moorings within an existing cluster of moorings in Waikawa Bay. The head of the Bay is largely given over to accommodation of boats within both the Marina and the swing moorings



and to activities and structures associated with boating. The continued occupation and use of the existing moorings is appropriate in this environment.

## Objectives & Policies of the Plan

**Clause 6.1.2, Policy 1.4** - *Recognise and provide for continued tangata whenua access to, and use, of traditional coastal resources such as maataitai, taiapure and taonga raranga.*

Comment: Waikawa Bay was historically a main food gathering and fishing area for Te Atiawa. The Bay was extensively fished and actively managed by them. Over time, with development of the Bay, much of those fisheries resources have been lost. Moorings within the Bay would have contributed to this loss of fisheries. This application is not for any extension of the moorings within the Bay and is only for the continued use of the existing moorings.

**Clause 9.2.1, Policy 1.3** - *Exclusive occupation of the coastal marine area or occupation which effectively excludes the public will only be allowed to the extent reasonably necessary to carry out the activity.*

Comment: The public is only excluded from the area of the moorings to the extent that certain activities such as jet ski-ing, windsurfing and the like are not possible. The public however can transit through the moorings to the extent mentioned previously in the discussion on navigational issues. The moorings are designed for the length of vessel that is to be moored on them.

**Policy 1.7** - *Avoid adverse effects from the occupation of coastal space in or around recognised casual mooring areas.*


Comment: The Bay is effectively one of the ports for Queen Charlotte and the wider Marlborough Sounds. The area of the moorings is given over to permanent anchorages for boats, but will eventually be reduced to the Mooring Management Areas defined in the Plan. Visiting boats do free anchor outside the moorings for short periods of time and there is ample space beyond the permanent moorings to do so.

**Clause 19.3, Policy 1.1** - *Avoid, remedy or mitigate the adverse effects of activities and structures on navigation and safety, within the coastal marine area.*

Comment: This issue was covered in the assessment of effects on navigational safety. While the current layout of moorings can be improved from a navigational safety point of view, this consent for the existing moorings will allow for the time to implement the MMA's and Bylaw while continuing the validation of those moorings.

## 7.5 Value of Existing Investment

For the purposes of s104(2A) of the RMA, the value of moorings to the mooring owners ranges from around \$4,000 to \$20,000 depending on size and location. The size of moorings is weighted more to the mid-range



to larger moorings. This group of moorings is estimated to have a combined value of investment of around 1.9 million dollars.

## 8 Potentially Adversely Affected Persons & Consultation

The application is for the continued formalisation of existing moorings in the Bay. These moorings will ultimately enjoy permitted activity status when they are finally accommodated within the MMA's.

The issues were well discussed and sorted through the Plan Change 21 process.

MBMA has therefore not consulted with any parties except Te Atiawa as the Tangata Whenua of the area and as one of the main parties to Plan Change 21.

## 9 Conclusions

This application is only for coastal permits for existing moorings in Waikawa Bay until such time as they can be legally managed under the Mooring Management Bylaw 2011 and also contained within the Mooring Management Areas that are already defined in the Marlborough Sounds Resource Management Plan.

There are no new matters since granting of the existing consents which may give rise to new adverse effects that were not previously assessed in the course of processing Plan Change 21. This Plan Change has only recently been approved by Consent Order from the Environment Court in August 2015.

The proposal is in accord with the New Zealand Coastal Policy Statement to the extent that it provides a holding pattern while the Bylaw becomes operative and the moorings are located within the MMA's.


The same applies as above in regards to the objectives and policies of the Marlborough Sounds Resource Management Plan.


1493-MBMA-Waikawa bulk mooring application



Appendix 1 – Location




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


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
