





Under section 92 of the Resource Management Act 1991, the Marlborough District Council requests further information for your application.

Requested Information

The further information required is detailed below.

- 1. Please provide the verification certificate if the water meter has been verified. If it has not then please note that a telemetered datalogger will most likely be required as a condition of consent, and it would make sense to get the meter system verified after this has been installed.
- 2. I note there have been no meter readings provided to the Council during the previous consent term except for some in 2009 and 2010. Please provide all the meter records from the previous water permit consent U090383.

Reasons for the Requested Information

The reasons for requesting further information are detailed below.

3. The above information is requested so I can better understand any actual or potential adverse effects on the environment from the proposed activity, and how any adverse effects may be avoided, remedied or mitigated.

Good morning Steve,

Thanks for that.

In regards to the meter and datalogger system because they weren't required to install telemetry in the previous consent I wouldn't require it to be installed and verified prior to consent being issued, I'll just include it as conditions of consent in this one, something like the following:

- 4. The consent holder shall maintain a meter on the abstraction well to measure water abstraction that is able to provide data in a form suitable for electronic storage. The meter is to exclusively record all water taken pursuant to this consent with an accuracy of plus or minus 5 percent. The meter shall have the number xxxx.
- 5. The meter must be verified by a suitably experienced person by (i.e. 3 months from the decision date). A copy of the verification certificate shall be provided to the Marlborough District Council within one month of the verification.
- 6. The consent holder shall install a data logger on the abstraction well to record and store water abstraction data at daily intervals. Data recorded is to be provided to the Marlborough District Council

by a telemetry system at daily intervals. The datalogger and telemetry is to be installed and operational by (i.e. 3 months from the decision date).

- 7. The consent holder must provide Council with photographic evidence and a date by which the datalogger and telemetry system is operational (capable of providing meter readings to Council via telemetry).
- 8. The meter, datalogger and telemetry system shall at all times be maintained in a fully workable condition.



- Only those submitters who indicate that they wish to speak at the hearing will be sent a copy of the section 42A hearing report.
- If you are making a submission to the Environmental Protection Authority, you should use form 16B.
- If you are a trade competitor, your right to make a submission may be limited by the trade competition provisions in Part 11A
